


Santa Clara County Court Schools

Percentage of Students Meeting State Standards









Students who participate in assessment testing while in a court school face many challenges. The population is very transient and students lack continuity in education. In addition those students who are incarcerated have historically scored lower on the standardized assessments tests. However data does tell a story. In the left or blue column we compare school, district and state in each year. In the right or yellow column we compare each component over time. The scores in the SCCOE Court Schools have declined over the 3 year period while scores at the state level have remained stable. Is this a change in methodology or a change in our approach to assessment? More data needs to be gathered to understand the trends for court schools and identify areas for improvement.
